**BSA Requirement?** For every 4 Cubs Registered, each Pack MUST have one, full-week, volunteer.  
**(Each Tiger Cub must have an adult partner volunteer).** ALL Volunteers must be registered with Boy Scouts of America and have completed Youth Protection and Weather Hazard Training.

**Refunds?** No refunds available, but can be transferred to another Scout or leader for the same event.

**Registration?** **Pre-registration is required** in order for us to provide program materials and supplies to all participants.  
**Registration as a Pack is a must. No Walk in registrations will be accepted.**

**Insurance?** All BSA registered youth and adult members of the Yucca Council are provided with Liability as well as Sickness and Accident Insurance.

### Camp Procedure/Rules

1. Every day, all campers and volunteers must wear the provided camp T-shirt. (Please wash every day).
2. All volunteers must arrive no later than 7:30am and may not leave until all cub scouts have been signed out.
3. Please be advised that all campers **must be signed in** with appropriate leaders daily no earlier than **7:30 am** and **must be signed out at 3:00 pm**. ( Campers must be signed in or out or will not be accepted.)
4. **Lunch is not provided.** Everyone must bring their own healthy lunch and snack. Gatorade or PowerAde will be allowed in moderation during this time.
5. Due to the extreme heat during camp we highly recommend for everyone to drink plenty of water throughout the day as well as Gatorade or PowerAde. Please no soft drinks or sugary drinks as they enhance dehydration. (i.e. Capri suns, Kool-Aid, sodas).
6. We encourage everyone to wear sun screen and a hat.
7. Campers/adults are not to bring knives and weapons, water pistols, electronic toys, or any other disruptive items to camp. Bullying, foul language or exposing themselves will not be tolerated. Campers/adults who violate any of these rules will result in disciplinary action that may include, but not limited to, camper/adult removal from camp and placement in appropriate disciplinary alternative setting and/or removal from program. Unauthorized items will be confiscated by an adult and returned to an authorized adult at the end of the day.
8. No smoking of any kind will be permitted.
9. No running in camp except for organized activities. You may NOT climb fences, trees, etc. You may NOT remove, discard, or relocate rocks, twigs, sticks, or other items found on the ground. You are NOT to throw objects unless it is part of an organized activity. Campers are to leave any stray or dead animals alone and will notify the Adult Leader.
10. Buddy System will be implemented at all times. Trips to bathroom, first aid station or anywhere else on camp will need to follow the buddy system rule. (Buddy system is a pair of campers/adults working together as required by BSA).
11. Designated bathrooms will be located outdoors in the port a pots. Inside bathrooms are for first aid use only.
12. All visitors must sign in at the gym and receive a pass before proceeding into camp. (i.e. parents, grandparents, aunts, uncles, cousins, etc.).
13. Absolutely no sandals or open shoes, No tank tops, or short shorts. Dress code will be enforced or sent home to change.
14. Please label all belongings brought to camp. (i.e. hats, backpacks, lunch bags, sun screen, water bottles, etc.)

### TRADING POST

- We are no longer accepting cash on hand at the Day Camp Trading Post.
- Tickets will be available for purchase at the Council Office and at Roundtables prior to Day Camp.
- Ticket costs are 2 for \$1.
- Snacks, toys, and other fun goodies will be available for trade with **tickets only**.
