- Cost?** **Extra Early Bird Registration is \$55 per scout/sibling till April 22nd.**

- Insurance?** Liability as well as Sickness and Accident Insurance are provided for all registered youth and adult members of the Yucca Council
- Refunds?** Refunds are not available, but pack may be transferred to another scout.

1. Pack Representative must turn in the complete Pack registration form with all the Cub scouts registrations.
2. **All Registrations will not be accepted without Personal health medical record form, Part A and B and up to date photo.** You can download this form <http://www.scouting.org/scoutsource/HealthandSafety/ahmr.aspx>
3. **All volunteers must attend a Day Camp orientation and turn in their Personal health medical form before. (Texas Youth Protection is a face to face class and will be on the day of Day Camp orientation. Weather Hazards must be completed online before and brought to the orientation)**
4. Refunds are not available, but pack may be transferred to another scout.(for this event only)
5. All communication about camp will be done by email, please make sure you write your email legibly.
6. Safety precautions and limited capacity require us to state that **all boys accepted must be in attendance for the entire week of camp...** This results in a high quality, safe camp that is fair to all attending.
7. All volunteers, cub scouts and boy scouts must be BSA registered to participate in camp.
8. **All Junior Staff must be registered in a scout unit and an adult from that unit must volunteer in order for the scouts in that unit to volunteer.**

Camp Procedure/Rules

1. Everyone must wear the Camp T-shirt that is provided every day.
2. Camp is run by volunteers so please drop off your scout no earlier than **7:30am** or pick him up no later than **3:30pm**. (Please advise who is going to pick up the child).
3. All volunteers must arrive no later than 7:30am and may not leave until all cub scouts have been signed out.
4. Lunch is **not** provided. Everyone must bring their own lunch. **Camp is nut free so please to make sure that you are not packing any nut items for lunch. There are many scouts with allergies please do not ruin it for your scout by packing anything with nuts.**
5. Bring plenty of water.
6. Come prepared wearing sun screen and a hat. (Remember we deal with hot weather during that time).
7. Campers are not to bring knives, water pistols, electronic toys, or any other disruptive items to camp. Unauthorized items will be confiscated by an adult and returned at the end of the day.
8. No running in camp except for organized activities. You may NOT climb fences, trees, etc. You may NOT remove, discard, or relocate rocks, twigs, sticks, or other items found on the ground. You are NOT to throw objects unless it is part of an organized activity. Campers are to leave any stray or dead animals alone and will notify the Adult Leader.
