Camp Pioneer is located near the Rio Grande River on the west side of El Paso. The camp is close to civilization while maintaining that outdoor experience. There are great campsites and many things to do at Camp Pioneer. Groups and units can plan action-packed fun and adventure activities and events for their Scouts.



Easy to get to, Camp Pioneer offers the ability to spend some quality time in the outdoors.

The terrain is sandy with tornillo, salt cedar, willow, and cottonwood trees. Campsites offer private areas for each group to camp and enjoy their time in the outdoors.



Camp Pioneer Facilities Available

Rock Lodge

The Rock Lodge is the main facility in the camp and dates back to the late 1930's when Zach White donated this property for youth outdoor activities. It has a meeting room, enclosed patio, and rustic lodge room with a working fireplace. The meeting room and lodge room connect to become one large room.



Ramadas

The Ramadas offer a large screened in patio room with a enough room for 30 people. This is great protection from the sun, wind, and rain. There is a working barbeque pit in each Ramada. There are patios situated at different locations on the property and can easily sit a den or patrol or two.



Shade Pavilions

There are four shade pavilions located in the camp where a group can hold a gathering or activity in the shade.



Camp Sites

The campsites are located around the camp and can hold almost any sized group. Each campsite has features to make outdoor camping fun and easy.

Splash Pad

The Splash Pad is a fun way to get wet and cool down in the summer months. This area provides fun for the whole group.



Flag Ceremony Area

There is a large flag pole in the open field in front of the rock lodge that groups can use for impressive flag ceremonies.



Campfire Ring

A campfire ring is available for larger gatherings and ceremonies.



BB Gun Range

There is a special area set aside with safety berms that can be used for BB Gun shooting with your group.

Archery Range

There is a special area set aside with safety berms that can be used for Archery shooting with your group
