Mr. Hahn is chairman and CEO of Rocky Mountain Mortgage Company, a mortgage banking company serving the west Texas and southern New Mexico markets. Mr. Hahn's community involvement includes having served as chairman and vice-chairman of the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board, the board is responsible for the strategic planning and policy of the state's higher education institutions and closing the gap in educational attainment throughout the state. He also served as chairman of the Camino Real Regional Mobility Authority, the primary entity responsible for major transportation infrastructure development in the El Paso region.
