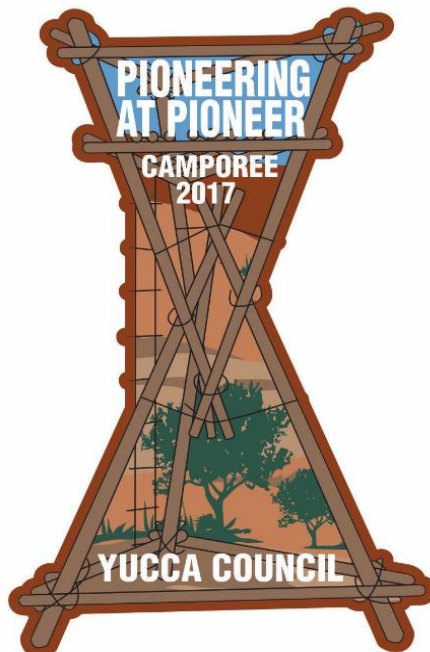

- What is it:** This camporee will test the Scout's skills on knots and lashings. It will also give the Webelos the opportunity to learn more, from the Boy Scout Troops in the area.
- Activities:** Troops will setup their own campsite, participate in the Troop/patrol challenges, cook their own meals, participate in the campfire and awards ceremony and more. On Saturday afternoon, the Webelos will have an opportunity to visit the Troop's campsites, to meet and interact with the Troop's Boy Scouts and Adult leadership.
- When & Where:** The event will be held Friday to Sunday, March 31st – April 2nd, 2017. Camp Pioneer at 4200 Girl Scout Lane, Sunland Park, NM 88063.
- Overnight Camping:** Troops are encouraged to camp overnight Friday and Saturday. Units will need to provide all tents, meals, equipment, and all other needs for overnight camping. There is no additional cost, as it is included in the \$10 registration fee.
- Day Trip:** Units are able to make a day trip, as most events will be run on Saturday.
- Registration:** Cost is \$10 per person. Webelos: \$5 to participate on Saturday or \$10 to include overnight camping. Patch is included for the first 200 registered Boy Scouts, Webelos and Adults. Pre-registration ends Thursday, March 30th at 5:00 pm. Walk-in registration is welcome on Friday from 6:00-8:00 pm, and Saturday from 7:00-8:30 am.
- Refunds:** Refunds will not be available, but will be transferable to another Scout.
- Supervision:** All units must have two-deep leadership in accordance with Youth Protection Guidelines, and all registered leaders must have completed Youth Protection Training.
- Insurance:** Liability as well as Sickness and Accident Insurance are provided for all registered youth and adult members of the Yucca Council.

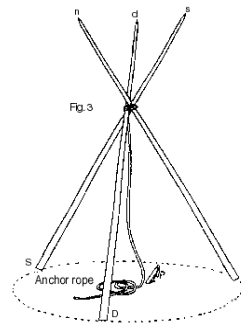

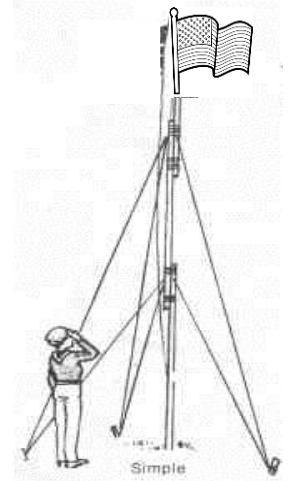

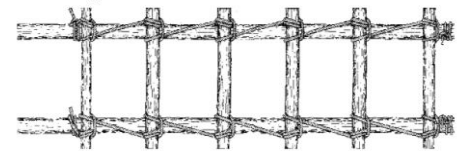

Flagpole race

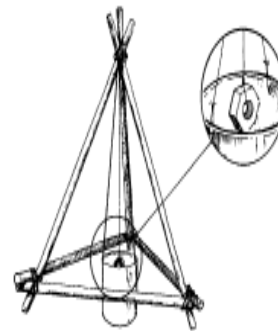


Ladder Bridge

Minimal materials Needed for Camporee: (provided by each Troop and Patrol):

1. 6 Poles (recommended size: 2 inch by 8 feet)
2. 9 Lashing Ropes (1/4" or 3/8" diameter, recommended 10-15 feet lengths)
3. Hammer/mallet
4. Pulley or Eye Bolt
5. Patrol Flag

Final Notes:

We encourage all Troops to bring a patrol flag, and prepare a patrol yell, cheer or song to share during the campfire. Troops are also encouraged to bring a display or presentation items, for the Webelos Roundup presentations.
