- What is it?** The Polaris District Day Camp is a 5 day camp for Cub Scouts entering Kindergarten-5th grade during the next school year. Siblings are welcome to attend as long as their parent is a volunteer. Each day will provide a fun opportunity for your scouts to have new experiences, with mighty adventures that will last a lifetime.
- Activities?** **Join us on this year's Fantastic Adventure:** sports, BB guns, bows and arrows, learn about nature, scout skills, arts & crafts, sing songs, work on rank advancement and Cub Scout pins, play games and make new friends!
- When & Where?** Monday, June 12th till Friday, June 16th, 2017 from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm at Camp Pioneer, 4200 Girl Scout Ln, Sunland Park, NM 88063
- Supervision?** **Each Pack is required to provide a minimum of one adult for every 4 youth register per pack; this requirement can be met by either a Full-Time Volunteer or a Job Share Volunteer.** Each Lion and Tiger Cub must have an adult partner. All Volunteers must be registered with BSA, and attend a volunteer orientation training.
- Cost?** **Early Registration is \$55 per scout/siblings till April 30th.**

- Insurance?** Liability as well as Sickness and Accident Insurance are provided for all registered youth and adult members of the Yucca Council.
- Refunds?** Refunds are not available, but money may be transferred to another scout. (for this event only).
- Registration?** **Pre-registration is required** in order for us to provide program materials to all participants.

1. Pack representative will collect registration forms or you can drop it off at the Council.
2. All Registrations will not be accepted without Personal health medical record form, Part A and B and up to date photo. You can download this form <http://www.scouting.org/scoutsource/HealthandSafety/ahmr.aspx>
3. All volunteers must attend a Day Camp orientation and turn in their Personal health medical form before. (Texas Youth Protection is a face to face class and will be on the day of Day Camp orientation. Weather Hazards must be completed online before and brought to the orientation)
4. Refunds are not available, but pack may be transferred to another Scout.(for this event only)All communication about camp will be done by email, please make sure you write your email legibly.
5. All volunteers, cub scouts and boy scouts must be BSA registered to participate in camp.
6. **All Junior Staff must be registered in a scout unit. It is preferred that an adult from that unit volunteers, but if that is not possible, it is expected for the Junior Staff to adhere to the Scout Oath and Scout Law.**

Camp Procedure/Rules

1. Everyone must wear the provided Camp T-shirt every day.
2. Camp is run by volunteers so please drop off your scout no earlier than **8:00am** or pick him up no later than **3:00 pm**. (Please advise who is going to pick up the youth).
3. All volunteers must arrive no later than 8:00 am and may not leave until all cub scouts have been signed out that day.
4. Lunch is **not** provided. Everyone must bring their own lunch. **Camp is nut free so please to make sure that you are not packing any nut items for lunch. There are many Scouts with allergies please do not ruin it for your Scout by packing anything with nuts.**
5. Bring plenty of water.
6. Come prepared wearing sun screen and a hat. (Remember we deal with hot weather during that time).
7. Campers are not to bring knives, water pistols, electronic toys, or any other disruptive items to camp. Unauthorized items will be confiscated by an adult and returned at the end of the day.
8. No running in camp except for organized activities. You may NOT climb fences, trees, etc. You may NOT remove, discard, or relocate rocks, twigs, sticks, or other items found on the ground. You are NOT to throw objects unless it is part of an organized activity. Campers are to leave any stray or dead animals alone and will notify the Adult Leader.
