DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

BACHELOR'S DEGREES

Unit and Administrative Commissioners

Prerequisites: Current registration as a commissioner, including those recently recruited. Completion of commissioner orientation. Completion of commissioner basic training is preferred (but not required).

Requirements: Completion of seven (7) courses of instruction, including three (3) required classes BCS 101, BCS 102, and BCS 104, along with four (4) elective classes. **Completed in one Saturday.**

Roundtable Commissioners and Staff

Prerequisites: Current registration as an RT Commissioner or staff member. Completion of RT Commissioner basic training is preferred (but not required).

Requirements: Completion of seven (7) courses of instruction, including three (3) required classes BRCS 201, BRCS 203, and BRCS 204, along with four (4) elective classes. **Completed in one Saturday.**

College of Boy Scouting

Prerequisites: Current registration as an adult leader in any Scouting unit. Completion of required on-line training for current position.

Requirements: Completion of seven (7) courses of instruction. **Completed in one Saturday.**

MASTER'S DEGREES

Unit and Administrative Commissioners

Prerequisites: Current registration as a commissioner, completion of a Bachelor's Degree and award of the Arrowhead Honor.

Requirements: Completion of seven (7) courses of instruction, including three (3) required classes MCS 301, MCS 302, and MCS 318, along with four (4) elective classes. **Completed in one Saturday.**

Roundtable Commissioners and Staff

Prerequisites: Current registration as an RT Commissioner or staff member, completion of a Bachelor's Degree and award of the Arrowhead Honor (RT Commissioner only, not staff).

Completed in one Saturday.

MASTER'S DEGREES (cont.)

~~*Requirements:* Completion of seven (7) courses of instruction, including three (3) required classes MRCS 401, MRCS 402, and MCS 403, along with four (4) elective classes. **Completed in one Saturday.**~~

College of Boy Scouting

Prerequisites: Current registration as an adult leader in any Scouting unit. Completion of required on-line training for current position and Bachelor's Degree.

Requirements: Completion of seven (7) courses of instruction. **Completed in one Saturday.**

DOCTORATE DEGREE

All Colleges

Prerequisites: Current registration as an adult leader and completion of a Master's Degree. Additionally:

- Earned one of the awards listed in the appropriate Course Catalog
- Recruit 3 new Scouters for designated positions
- Serve on respective College faculty for 1 year
(Consult Course Catalog for specific details)

Requirements: Completion of ten (10) courses of instruction, including three (3) required classes DCS 501, DCS 502, and DCS 503, along with two (2) other DCS elective classes and five (5) other elective classes not attended for the Bachelor's or Master's Degrees. Completion of a thesis or research project on any topic of value to Scouting in the local Council. The Assistant Dean of the doctor's program or the staff adviser must approve the topic and final paper or project.
