Code of Conduct

Guidelines for Scouts, Adult Volunteers and Leaders Selling Popcorn

- Ideally, each popcorn booth will have no more than 4 people present at all times. That includes two parents and two Scouts.
- All Scouts participating at a popcorn booth, or walking a neighborhood to sell popcorn will wear their Field uniform.
- The Scout and/or adult volunteer will not participate in the act of panhandling (i.e., directly or indirectly, Unit tip jar, asking for the donation of money instead of selling popcorn).
- This is a Council Sponsored Popcorn Fundraiser, which means supplemental items like water, jerky, hot dogs, candy, car wash, etc. are not permitted to be sold.
- Samples of products shall NOT be given to customers, as it is a health code violation.
- Scouts will not break open the product and sell the products in quantities less than the way they are packaged.
 Nutritional information must be on all packages.
- All storefront popcorn booths will be setup in the area designated by the store manager.

deliberate attempt to cause physical harm is unacceptable.

- The Scouts will not ambush or crowd customers as they come in and out of the store. The Scouts will stay 8–10 feet away from the door or at a distance as designated by the store manager.
- If by chance two Scout units show up to the same storefront to sell popcorn, the adult volunteers will work out the issue <u>without</u> involving the store manager. No more than one unit per storefront.
- All Scouts and adult volunteers will use clean and kind language. There shall be no profanity, put-downs or verbal taunting, as this is unacceptable.
 All Scouts will behave in a friendly manner. Punching, "play fighting", throwing objects, choking, and any
- All Scouts will be respectful of the storefront displays and not sit, climb, play on any fixtures or displays in front of stores. And will leave the storefront cleaner than they found it. Taking all empty popcorn boxes with them.
- All Scouts will remain on the sidewalk and not enter the parking lot for sales or to help a customer to a car.
- The Scouts and adult volunteers will always abide by store rules when selling at a storefront or on business property, in addition to the other bullet points on this document.
- ALL CASH DONATIONS/TIPS units receive during store front sales will be put towards their Heroes & Helpers donations collected.
